Dear Parent / Carers,

Thank you for your efforts in supporting your children during the last week and for your ongoing support of the school. It has certainly been another interesting week and not the week anyone of us wanted to happen.

Braunstone Town Council library is open for click and collect at certain times during the week. This is an excellent chance for both children and adults to get books and enjoy some quality reading time together. If you have books at home or choose to get some from the library remember that reading is about enjoyment and not about moving up levels. As an adult I have some favourite books that I keep going back to and read again, it is the same for children. Just reading and asking questions about the events, characters and their feelings would be beneficial along with predicting what happens next. Also asking questions that link to recapping events after a few pages as well as the whole book. This focuses children's thinking into specific events as well as the whole story. All these skills can be developed with any level of book. Reading a familiar book can help with pace, fluency and expression - all key skills. Above all get your children to just sit and enjoy a book for a few minutes everyday (it can also give you a break from the pressures of home schooling / working from home). The government issued further guidance last night and there have been some changes to some of the remote learning provision.
