

Year 3: Autumn Term 2023

ENGLISH	MATHS
In English, we are following the novel approach to learning and we will be reading <i>The Snail and the Whale</i> and <i>The Stone Age: Hunters, Gathers and Wooley Mammoths</i> . Through this, we will be exploring a range of text types including instructions, non-chronological reports, persuasive letters, playscripts and narratives.	In Maths, we will be developing our understanding of place value up to 1000. We will also be developing our number fluency in addition and subtraction whereby we will be introducing the column method. This will involve regrouping and exchanging practically and using the written method.

SCIENCE	HISTORY	GEOGRAPHY
In Science, we will be studying the properties of rocks, classifying them into groups to discover why particular rocks are used for different purposes. Also, we will be focusing on forces and how movement can be classified into push, pull and twist.	This term in History, we will be learning about the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. We will be focusing on crime and punishment, childhood, invention, significant individuals and households across these time periods.	The focus of Geography this term is mountains, volcanoes and earthquakes. We will be learning about the parts of a volcano, how they are formed and about eruptions. We will learn the names of some famous mountains and what an earthquake is.

COMPUTING	DESIGN	ART
We will begin Computing with coding which will require the children to debug faulty software and create their own programs on Purple Mash. We will also focus on online safety, spreadsheets and touch typing.	We will be linking our D&T outcome with our Geography learning. The children will be presented with a problem scenario which they have to resolve using their knowledge of levers and linkages.	In Art, we will be creating our own cave paintings to link to our History topic. To achieve our outcomes, we will explore a range of mediums including oil pastels, chalk and printing techniques.

MUSIC	R.E.	P.E.
Our focus this term will be Voice and Pulse. We will listen to a range of music and have opportunity to compose our own within a group.	Children will be learning the Christian creation story and reflect upon how this impacts the lives of Christians. We will also learn about different Sikh gurus and their role in Sikhism.	This term's focus will be cricket and invasion games. We will be exploring the techniques of striking and fielding. Indoor PE will involve balance, rolling and jumping into a sequence with a partner.
