ENGLISH	MATHS
In English, we are following the novel approach to learning and we will be reading <i>Escape from Pompeii</i> and <i>The butterfly lion</i> . Through this, we will be exploring a range of text types including newspaper report, poem and narrative. In summer 2 we will be focusing on non-chronological report and debate.	In Maths, we will be concluding our unit on multiplication and division. We will be introducing length and perimeter, fractions, mass and capacity. We will be particular be focusing on our reasoning questions to answer more complex questions.

SCIENCE	HISTORY	GEOGRAPHY
In Science, we will be exploring magnet. We will be studying the the poles and which materials are magnetic. On the second half of the term we will be looking at light. We will investigate sources of light and how shadows are formed.	This term in History, we will be learning about the Roman. We will be focusing on crime and punishment, childhood, invention, significant individuals and households within Roman Society.	The focus of Geography this term we will be co-ordinates, maps and points of compass. We will be learning how to locate places on a map and communicate findings. We will be creating detailed field work sketches with geographical keys.

In touch typing they will develop their hand positions in relation to the home keys on the keyboard.	We will be linking our D&T outcome with our History learning. The children will be presented with a problem scenario which they have to resolve using their knowledge of Roman Citizen.	For our art sequence of learning, we will be exploring clay as a medium. This will include developing the children's confidence with using clay and adding texture, investigating joining through scratch and slip and exploring coiling techniques.

Our focus this term will be Rhythm and Pitch. We will listen to a range of music and have opportunity to compose our own within a group.	Children will be learn about the Islam faith this term.
