

# Year 3: Summer Term 2024

ENGLISH	MATHS
In English, we are following the novel approach to learning and we will be reading <i>The Boy who Grew Dragons</i> and <i>My Best Friend the Suffragette</i> . Through this, we will be exploring a range of text types including diary, narrative and persuasive speech. In Summer 2 we will be focusing on persuasive letters and newspaper reports.	In Maths, we will be concluding our unit on fractions. We will begin money, time, shape and statistics. We will particularly be focusing on our reasoning questions to answer more complex questions.

SCIENCE	HISTORY	GEOGRAPHY
In Science, we will be exploring plants. We will be studying the different parts of a plant and their functions. In the second half of the term we will be looking at animals. We will identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition.	This term in History, we will be learning about our local history, primarily the history of Braunstone and the Winstanley family. We will also be focusing on crime and punishment, childhood, invention, significant individuals and households relating to the Anglo-Saxons.	The focus of Geography this term we will be learning to identify continents, countries and counties on maps. We will also study the human and physical features within our locality as well as compare different destinations.
COMPUTING	DESIGN	ART
In Computing we will also focus on e-mails and databases. During the e-mail unit they will understand how to stay safe when sending and receiving emails. We will learn how to send an e-mail and attach a file and use the CC feature. They will learn how important databases are and how useful they can be.	We will be linking our D&T outcome with our History learning. The children will be presented with a problem scenario which they have to resolve using their knowledge of the suffragettes.	For our art sequence of learning, we will be completing our collage unit, where we have explored overlaying and overlapping materials to create a landscape. During the summer term, Year 3 will be delving into our print unit, where we will investigate using and creating printing blocks.
